

*DHH Lengel Middle School's
Schuylkill Achieve After-school Program
Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)*

1. Does my child/children have to attend everyday of the program?

No, attendance at the program is not mandatory on a daily basis. Attendance is tracked for the safety of our students, students not at Achieve (unless they are absent or left early from school) will receive a phone call home to verify that they have made it home.

2. Does my child/children have to stay the entire time?

The program runs from 3pm-6pm. Students are not required to attend the entire time, however students are not permitted to leave without a parent note/email.

3. Is there transportation available after the program?

There is no transportation provided by the school district after the program. Students will either be dismissed as walkers or need a ride home.

4. Will my child get homework help/tutoring?

During the After-school program, students are provided the opportunity to complete their homework and request tutoring, however the program is designed to provide additional enrichment activities.

5. Can I register my child after the program has already started?

Yes, Schuylkill Achieve has open enrollment policy. Students can be registered at any time by a parent/guardian with the use of the Google Registration Form.
